

ARACHID'S REST



Haunted Hook Creations

Materials

- Black size #4 cotton yarn
 - This pattern uses 1 skein of Lily Sugar 'n Cream in "Black"
- White size #4 cotton yarn
 - This pattern uses 1 skein of Lily Sugar 'n Cream in "White"
- 3.75mm (F) crochet hook
- Scissors
- Pins
- Yarn Needle

Abbreviations

- St(s) – stitch(es)
- Ch – chain stitch
- SC – single crochet
- Sl st – slip stitch
- Inc – increase stitch
- [] – repeat the stitches indicated inside brackets
- (#) – the number of stitches in the row

Notes

- This pattern is written in US terms.
- I highly recommend using cotton yarn for this pattern. Cotton will absorb condensation and hold its shape better when being cleaned than acrylic.
- When forming the chains, I recommend leaving the lead/slipknot end a bit longer so you can pull it through your stitching and help secure the chains.
- Make sure to sew the center tightly so that glasses will sit flat.

Instructions

Base: Make 2

with a 3.75mm (F) crochet hook

In Black:

Row 1: 6 S in MC (6)

Row 2: Inc × 6 (12)

Row 3: [SC, Inc] × 6 (18)

Row 4: [SC, Inc, SC] × 6 (24)

Row 5: [3 SC, Inc] × 6 (30)

Row 6: [2 SC, Inc, 2 SC] × 6 (36)

Row 7: [5 SC, Inc] × 6 (42)

Row 8: [3 SC, Inc, 3 SC] × 6 (48)

Row 9: [7 SC, Inc] × 6 (54)

Row 10: [4 SC, Inc, 4 SC] × 6 (60)

Row 11: [9 SC, Inc] × 6 (66)

Row 12: [5 SC, Inc, 5 SC] × 6 (72)

Row 13 (for 1st base): Sl st into next St, fasten off and weave in tail

Row 13 (for 2nd base): Sl st into next St, fasten off and leave a tail for sewing



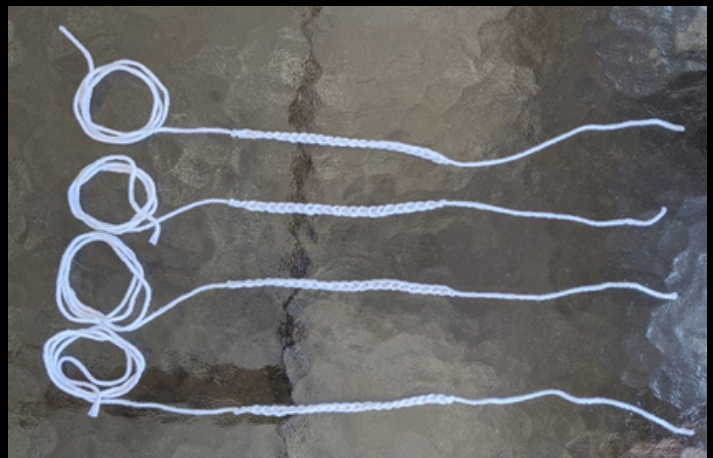
Cross Webbing: Make 4

with a 3.75mm (F) crochet hook

In White:

Row 1: Chain 22

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.



Circular Webbing: Small Circle

with a 3.75mm (F) crochet hook

In White.

Row 1. Chain 24

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

Circular Webbing: Medium Circle

with a 3.75mm (F) crochet hook

In White.

Row 1. Chain 38

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

Circular Webbing: Large Circle

with a 3.75mm (F) crochet hook

In White.

Row 1. Chain 52

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.



Pre-Assembly

Pieces

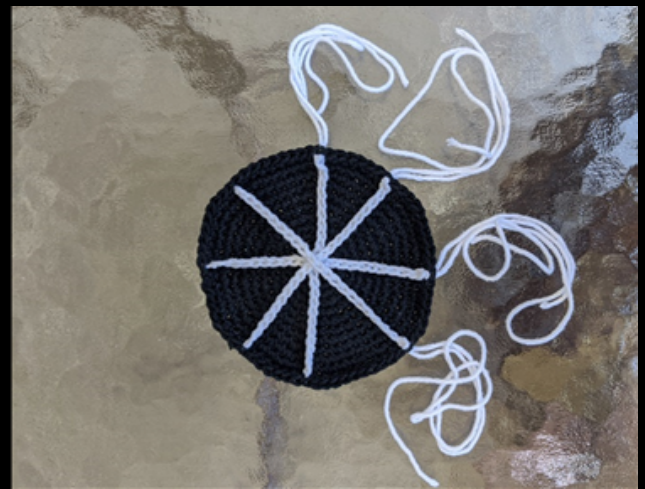
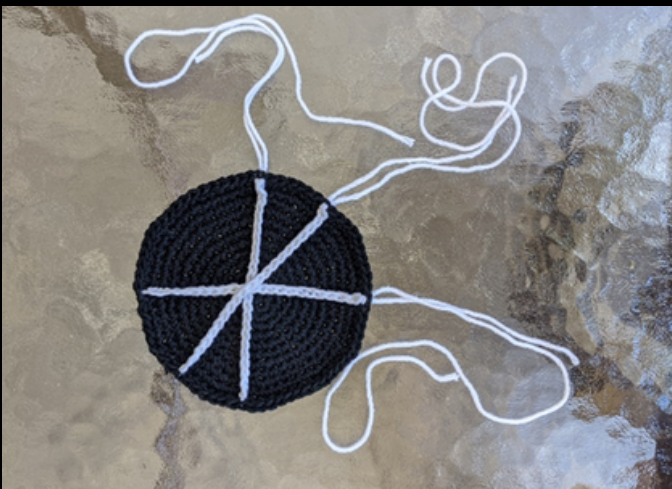
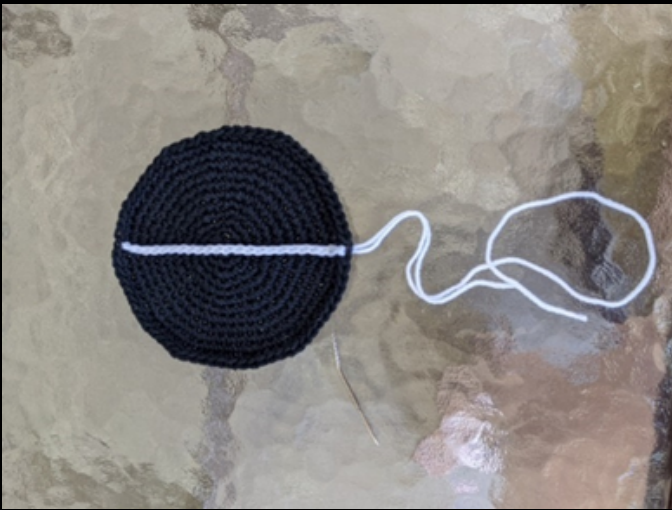
You should now have
2 bases and 7 chains.



Assembly

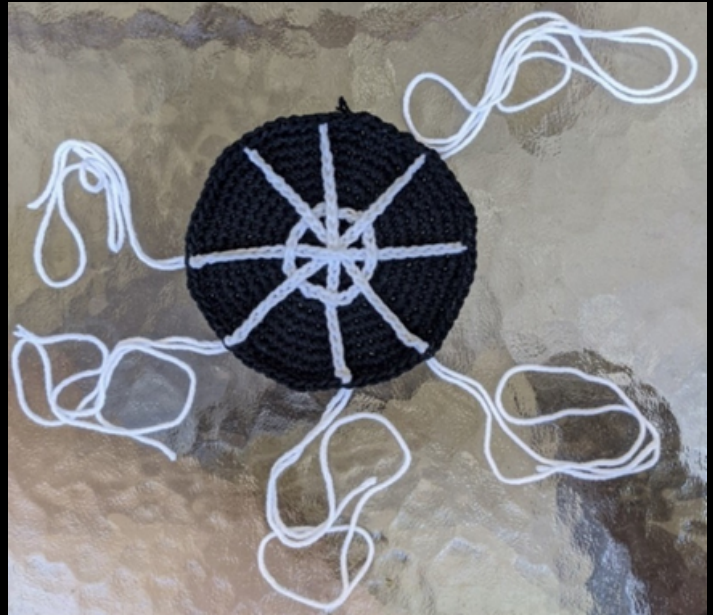
Chains

Sew the 4 chains of cross webbings (Ch 22) in alternating crossing X shapes at the edge of the coaster bases. It should leave 8 sections. You can pull the other end of the chains through the same stitch. Do not sew down the rest of the chain yet and do not cut and tie off your tail yet - the looseness will allow you to weave the circular webbings through the cross webbings.

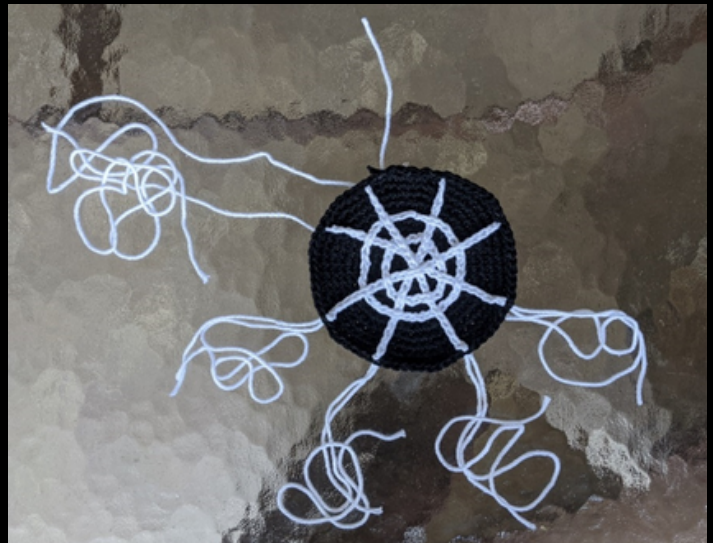


Chains (cont.)

Weaving the chain over and under the cross webbings to create depth, sew the small circle (Ch 24) between rows 3 and 4 in a circular shape. You can pull the head end of the chain through the last stitch.



Weaving the chain over and under the cross webbings to create depth, sew the medium circle (Ch 38) with 2 rows between this circle and the previous circle. You can pull the head end of the chain through the last stitch. I recommend alternating the over-under pattern from the previous circle.



Chains (cont.)

Weaving the chain over and under the cross webbings to create depth, sew large circle (Ch 52) with 2 rows between this circle and the previous circle. I recommend alternating the over-under pattern from the previous circle.

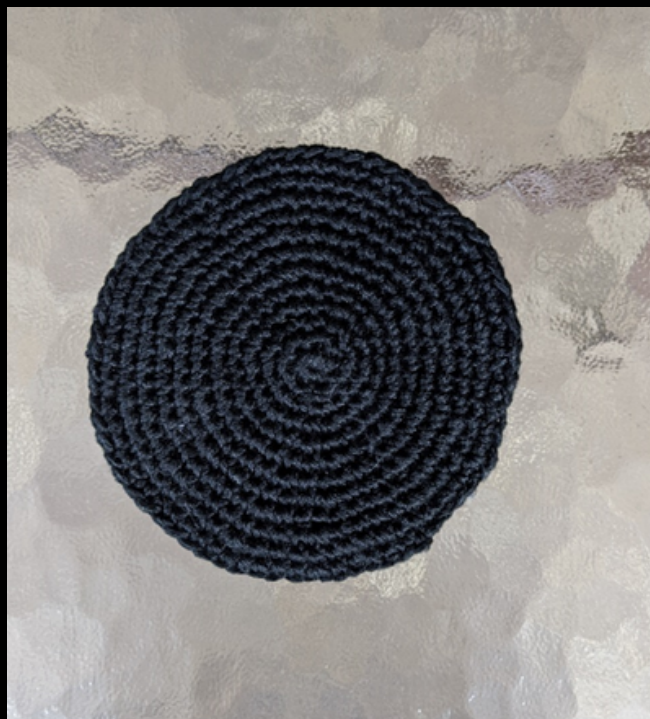
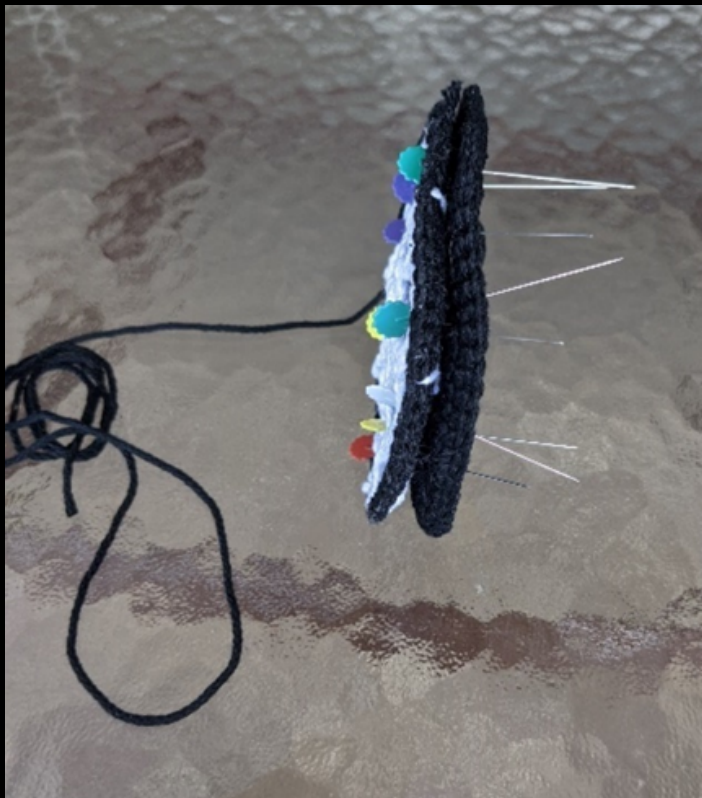


Now is a good time to sew the rest of the cross webbings so they are secure.

Sew the 2nd base back-to-back with the 1st (I suggest using pins to hold them in place). This will cover the white stitching on the back of the 1st base. Make sure you sew securely enough so both bases lay flat against each other. I recommend going around the edges through the last row of single crochets and then sewing points throughout the blank black spaces of both pieces of the coaster. Weave your end in.



Chains (cont.)



Congratulations! You now have your completed Arachnid's Rest.
